At the moment this is not endorsed so whilst we are trying to get the projects into the 10 year capital plan there is no guarantee that happens.

Nic had spoken to Shane Field and was organised to meet with the Stawell FNC board Tuesday 16 <sup>th</sup> July 2024 to sit down and have a chat through the lease agreement and any questions or other concerns that the club had from their point of view.  North Park user agreements will also need to be updated ASAP and Nic will be organising meetings with user groups that hold agreements.

This is not to say that clubs/groups can't come to Northern Grampians Shire officers with potential grants to see if we can assist in anyway.
